

This is a wonderful book. In *The Way of Thomas*, John Mabry has advanced and broadened the thinking regarding the Gospel of Thomas. Discovered in 1945, and the subject of much biblical scholarship, this authentic collection of the sayings of Jesus, has excited and puzzled its readers for half a century. In this, his latest book, Mabry gives us the result of his years of discovery and

meditation on the gospel held sacred by the Jewish Christians. After briefly telling the story of the Thomas School of Jewish Christians and the strange discovery of the gospel, this book presents nine "insights" found in Mabry's study of these 114 sayings. The reader is guided through a discovery process which takes us to a radically new understanding of what Jesus might have been about all those 2000 years ago. We know Jesus came to tell us to love one another, and to heal, and to exist in an accepting community. We also know, if we've thought about it much, that there seems to be so much more to this mysterious person. The Way of Thomas shows us another level of this mystery. According to Mabry, Jesus was trying to tell his followers that divinity is all around and all through every one of us. We live in a God-infused world and we are separated from this knowing by our very human needs and desires. As Insight One states, "there is only one thing in the universe, and you are that thing." At the end of each segment there are exercises to draw the reader further into his/her own understanding of that insight. In the same way that the members of the Thomas school thought the sayings to be salvific, I found that reading the book and contemplating the exercises re-engaged my own sense of the mystery of God. You can expect to find a very unitive-consciousness treatment of these sayings augmented by complementary wisdom from a variety of faith traditions. The Way is Thomas is written in a clear compelling style. I highly recommend it.

While it may be highly controversial to many, the path revealed by John Mabry of the influence of Thomas's Christianity on the Western world, is the way out of the maze of what has been for many individuals (though not all) the debilitating repression of personal religious freedom and thought which has been brought on by a fundamentalist interpretation of the life and words of Jesus. Mabry's book is the leading edge of at least the next hundred years of exploration of a new look and a new way of understanding and benefitting from the life that Jesus chose to lead. For example, Mabry emphasizes the compatibility of Thomas's Christianity with all other major world religions, as opposed to the fundamental interpretation that pits it against all other world religions. Mabry's book reveals the steady, relentless centuries-in-developing shift from a hierarchical-only access to God, to that of the individual finding the God experience within - a message Jesus and all other major religions have been saying all along. "The Way of Thomas" further opens up the prospect of unlimited ways to redefine the role of "church" in our society, offering mental, emotional and physical outlets for personal growth and exploration toward a more vital and alive life of human spirituality and religious experience. But Mabry doesn't just talk about it - he practices it in his North Grace Community Church in Berkeley, California. (More information is available on this from

Google.) But I must emphasize that Thomas's Christianity is not for everyone. Paul's and John's fundamental Christianity is a powerful force which has brought meaning to many for centuries and will continue to do so. It has inspired the most creative expressions appearing throughout the history of music, art, literature, even science, and most recently in humanitarian aid to distressed nations. But for a growing number of people, Fundamentalism no longer speaks to their needs, and Mabry's Thomas does. I highly recommend this book to those who are seeking. Robert Rock
