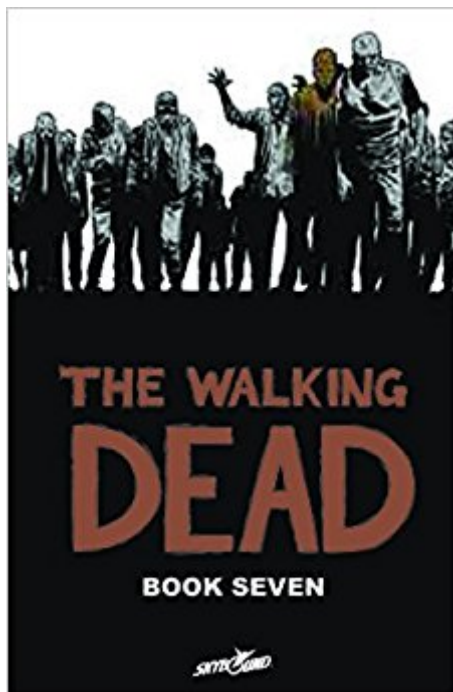

In Book Seven of The Walking Dead we rejoin our heroes in the Alexandria Safe-Zone. Unfortunately, the story hasn't had the same pop ever since they left the prison. Unfortunately, that doesn't change here, despite a game effort. Alexandria is a very different situation from the prison on paper, but that doesn't mean much, because it feels too similar and it just isn't as interesting. Things do end on a high note though, and the story is looking up (a potential partially shown by Book Eight). Extras in this specific edition include the full-color comic book covers, assorted miscellaneous artwork (including artwork for a Walking Dead board game), and musings on the artwork by Robert Kirkman. Kirkman does a wonderful job of making the characters come to life. Once you pick up these books, you won't put them down. Although it's a comic book, you get sucked into the story and start to pose the same questions that the characters do to each other. It's so much more than just zombies, it's a story of human nature and how far anyone will go to survive. Once you've read enough of these books, you can start to see parallels in the TV show. I find myself telling all my friends how the comic and the show are different, but how similar they are too. Even if you don't like comic books, you'll love this series.
