

Ann Cox is a silk ribbon embroidery designer who runs her own company selling silk ribbons and kits. She also teaches at colleges of further education.

This book was just what I needed to make the flowers I was looking for. My learning style is a combination of touch and doing, so this really helped me by keeping the pictures in front of me to verify that what I am doing looks like what the pictures do. This book doesn't go into designing where to put the flowers in a pattern so you will need to practice using your imagination on that part.

I am very impressed with Ms. Cox's books. She has the know-how, and the ability to impart it to others. Photographs and drawings show how to do the stitches (and in some cases what to do

when it goes wrong!), and she does not only project ideas but also individual instructions for particular flowers, so you can make your own. If you can only buy one or two books, make sure her name is on them. I've been disappointed with others, but not here. Really impressive!
