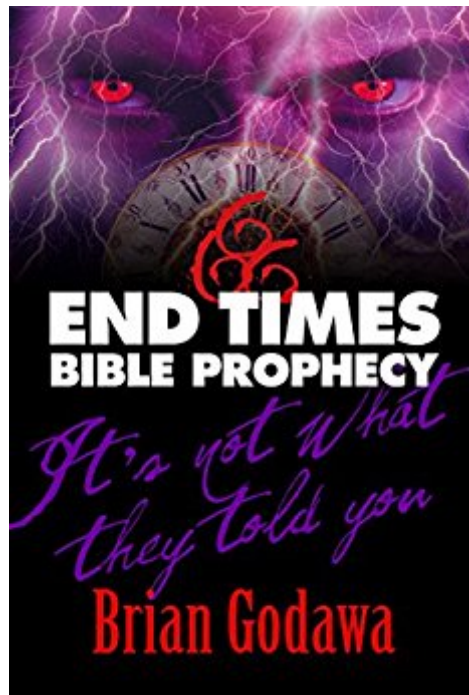




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# End Times Bible Prophecy: It's Not What They Told You

I've have been coming to some of the same conclusions as Brian presents in this book, but without the extensive research he presents in this book. There are several things he wrote that are prompting me to rethink previous positions. I like the straightforward way he presents his arguments and references. I would recommend this to anyone who is tired of the hype and sensationalism that has been presented as "fact" for far too long.

Again, a well written book by Brian Godawa. I enjoy his style and this is a very good compilation to get started on a journey into the truth of the scriptures. I have to say, though, this is not the end of the discussion. Keep learning, but most importantly, study the scriptures for yourself and see if these things be so. I have been a preterist (hate labels!) for several years now, and I am amazed at how much there is yet to learn.

You don't have to agree with Brian Godawa. You don't have to hold his views on eschatology. You can absolutely disagree with him, but the one thing you cannot do is claim he hasn't done his research. His discussions and research into the Hebrew mindset and the first century

understandings of colloquialisms and poetic language lend themselves to a second and even a third thought. His struggle with dispensationalism and futurism and preterism and all the interpretations of scripture as they pertain to the end of all things reads like my own. I can relate to his thought process and to his questions. I've enjoyed the research he has done for his fictional book series and this is simply an extension of that research and study. So go ahead, read it. Decide for yourself. Look at scripture through the eyes of those who wrote it, and those who would have received it. Make your own choices, but I for one am glad to have voices like Brian's out there giving us all something to think about critically, because we are to love God with all our MIND as well.

Another Brian Godawa winner! With great insight and historical clarity the author presents a preterist view of the end times. For those among us who have been smothered by a futurist only teaching this book allows the mind and heart to view the Scriptures the way the early church received the inspired writings. My journey from futurism to preterism parallels the writer's in many ways. This is a wonderful book to share with many who are confused and conflicted about Bible prophecy, theologically liberating.

Great introductory book to partial preterist eschatology. It does a good job of concisely arguing for and defending the view. The two things I liked the most about the book were its helpful definitions of key terms (e.g. the abomination of desolation) and its rigorous contextualizing (both textually and culturally) of biblical passages related to eschatology. For those laypeople (like me) with precious little time for leisure reading about advanced theological topics, this is the perfect book for such a topic.

Good book that mirrored my own foray into eschatology years ago. I had a die-hard view, but so many other views had just as much scriptural support, I wasn't sure what to think. This one makes a lot of sense to me, and still leaves a sense of immanency as we still know that there will still be a second coming one day. This isn't the end of prophecy, just showing how things were fulfilled in the past, but we still have more to come.

It is wonderful that Brian Godawa is spreading his insights into Bible prophecy. So much misinformation and so many falsehoods about end-time prophecy have permeated evangelical Christianity that many Christians don't even realize that there are sound scriptural alternatives to the pre-trib "left behind" futurism teachings. Shout it from the housetops Brian!
