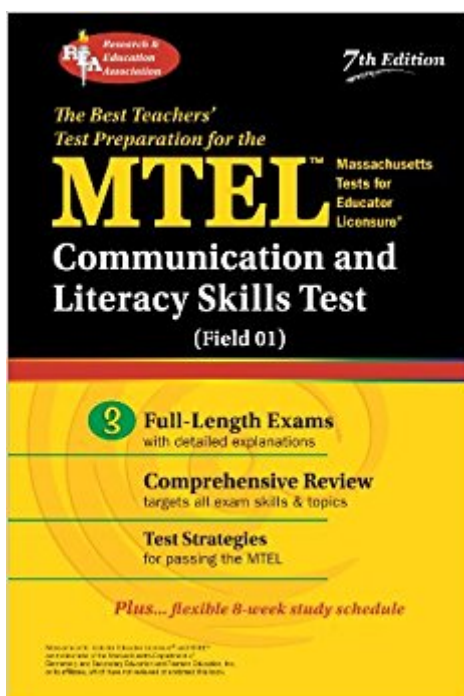

Always monitor the website for the latest information and updates. Is there a registration fee? To take the Communication and Literacy Skills Test, you must pay a fee. A complete summary of the registration fees is included in your registration bulletin. When will I receive my score report? Your score report should arrive about five weeks after you take the test. No scoring information will be given via telephone or fax. Remember,

the data on your score report will reflect your scaled score, not the number of questions you have answered correctly. All tests are reported on the same scale, and will not be compared to the score of any other examinees. You can view unofficial test results on the MTEL website at 5:00 p.m. on the score report days. To receive a passing score on the Communication and Literacy Skills Test, you must attain a qualifying score on both the reading and writing subtests. If you do not pass one or both of the subtests, you will be able to register again for the necessary section(s).

This book probably did me more of a disservice than good. There were typos in the correct answers in the practice tests, repetitive questions in the reading section, arbitrary answers that weren't even mentioned in the text, etc. I got more frustrated by trying to decipher what questions meant and making my way through error-ridden answers than actually learning. Don't buy!

I just completed the MTEL Communications and Literacy exam 3 days ago and I feel that this book has more than adequately prepared me for the test. It covers everything and the test was actually easier than the sample tests in the book (or maybe it just seems that way after extensive study). I highly recommend this book to anyone preparing to take the MTEL Communication and Literacy exam.

I bought this for my daughter so I can't claim to have used/read it myself. I can tell you that my daughter did use it and passed her MTEL exam on the first attempt. So it clearly has merit.

This was a great way for me to review the basics needed to pass the MTEL 01 test. I recommend it for anyone who needs to brush up on basic grammar and such.

I'm using the 2011 copy of this text. I just finished using the passage in Practice Test #3 for writing a summary. This passage is the worst one yet. First off, what's "up" with the superscripts?? It seems it was intended to be used for multiple choice questions but the editors forgot to edit it omit them--for four years in a row! Plus, there are superscripts of numbers attached to words that reference to ... NOTHING. Also, the sentence order is fragmented. Presentation is horrendous, summary passage for Practice Test #1 does not indent their paragraphs but number them. Passage 2 and 3 indent,

without numbering. Passage 2 looks 'normal'. And passage 3, I repeat, has these odd superscripts. What has been concurrent in all of the passages for summaries is that they all have errors in it: often fragmented, verbose sentences, inconsistent reference citations, and grammar issues--"You want me to summarize a passage with a bunch of grammatical errors? Why thank you."The LearningExpress publication -Â MTEL: Communication and Literacy Skills (01)Â has better writing summary passages. They are of similar to the ones available at mtel.nesinc.com and are ... grammatically correct! Also, it offers sample answers to summaries; REA does not. Still, both texts contain errors in the multiple choice portion of the Reading \*AND\* Writing sections. Sometimes, all answer choices are incorrect or an answer choice will be listed twice(?!) or something of similar antagonizing effect. Good luck, folks.

I was disappointed with this book. I didn't notice any real problems with the first practice test I took, but I wasn't looking to see if the book had errors. When I was in the process of completing the second test I realized that there were some real problems. There is no consistency. When grading part of the writing test I realized that the book is wrong. Some of the questions are really easy (not all but some) and the answers they give are completely wrong. It is very frustrating that I am unable to know what my practice test score is because I am unsure if the book is correct. Do not bother purchasing this book. It is a waste of time and money. Focus on the practice test the MTEL website provides.

This book contains mistakes. Mistakes as in; they say an answer is wrong, when it is right - SO FRUSTRATING.

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
