Renowned worldwide for his playful, innovative storytelling and humorous, distinctive art style, Akira Toriyama burst onto the manga scene in 1980 with the wildly popular Dr. Slump. His hit series Dragon Ball (published in the U.S. as Dragon Ball and Dragon Ball Z) ran from 1984 to 1995 in Shueisha's Weekly Shonen Jump magazine. He is also known for his design work on video games such as Dragon Quest, Chrono Trigger, Tobal No. 1, and most recently, Blue Dragon. His recent manga works include COWA!, Kajika, Sand Land, Neko Majin, and a children's book,

Toccio the Angel. He lives with his family in Japan.

Dragon Ball Super isn't bad. It just isn't on par with Dragon Ball/Dragon Ball Z. It lacks both the adventurous humor of early Dragon Ball and the epic story of the Freeza/Cell arcs in Dragon Ball Z. It is a continuation of the lackluster incongruity of the Boo Saga, with unappealing character designs, over-the-top power creep, endless anticlimactic transformations, and uber-powerful yet unimposing villains. This volume moves very fast, presumably to catch up with the anime it's adapted from. The Resurrection of F story gets a couple panels and a caption.

Toyotaro's art gives you that "blood boiling" feeling of reading the original Dragon Ball manga. I would definitely recommend this version of Super over the anime. Viz's translations are what you'd expect from the original run of Dragon Ball/Z, which aren't always ideal (Hercule, Vegerot), but still good overall. This collected volume includes a few hilarious bonus drawings by Toyotaro, and a really interesting joint interview of Toyotaro and Akira Toriyama. Can't wait for Volume 2, 3, 4...etc.!
