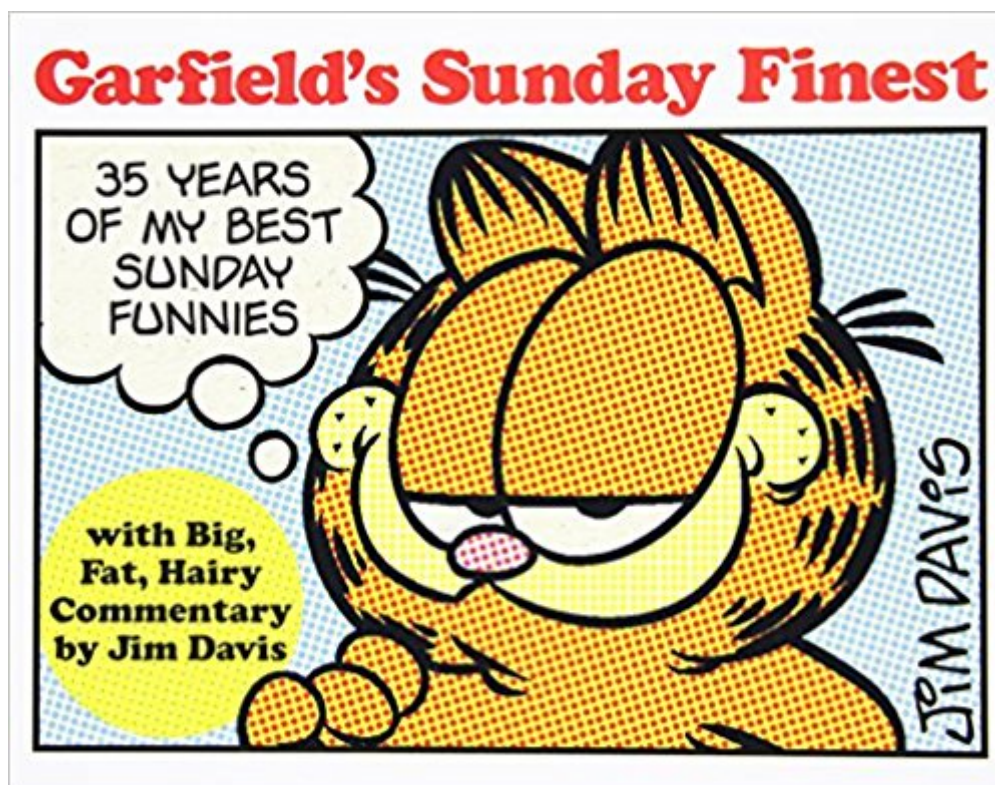

Jim Davis was born on July 28, 1945, in Marion, Indiana. He later attended Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana, where he distinguished himself by earning one of the lowest cumulative grade point averages in the history of the university. (Incidentally, a fellow classmate named David Letterman earned the other). The Garfield strip was born on June 19, 1978, syndicated in forty-one U.S. newspapers. Today itâs syndicated in more than 2,100 newspapers worldwide with more than 200 million readers, leading Guinness World Records to name Garfield The Most Widely Syndicated Comic Strip in the World. Davis has had many successes with Garfield, including four Emmy Awards for Outstanding Animated Program and induction into the Licensing Hall of Fame (1998), but his most prized awards are from his peers in the National Cartoonist Society: Best Humor Strip (1981 and 1985), the Elzie Segar Award (1990), and the coveted Reuben Award (1990)

for overall excellence in cartooning.

Everyone at our house loves Garfield comics, so this was a wonderful addition to the family collection. The behind-the-scenes commentary by Jim Davis was fun, and the fact that he uses assistants in his work an eye opener. Overall, we had a great time with this over the holidays.

I really enjoyed the book. It bought back childhood memories, of when I collected and read some the books. I'm hooked, I going to read Garfield books again. It really takes your mind off of daily problems, and brings in enjoyment.

My six year old son is obsessed with Garfield cartoons so I thought this would be the prefect Christmas present to bring in literacy and reading with a topic that he loves. I was right, he loves it and hearing his belly laughs when we read each comic is priceless.

This book is a little different from other compilations. It includes both the logo box and the drop panels not usually found in this type of book. Reading this is like looking at the cartoons as they originally appeared in the newspapers. Some of the panels have copies of the drafts next to them or a little bit over them. That can be an irritation to some, but it's not too bad with this edition. I recommend this to anyone who is a Garfield fan and likes to see how the cartoons originally appeared.

I bought it as a birthday present for my 9 year old niece. She is crazy about Garfield comics. She loved the book a lot!
