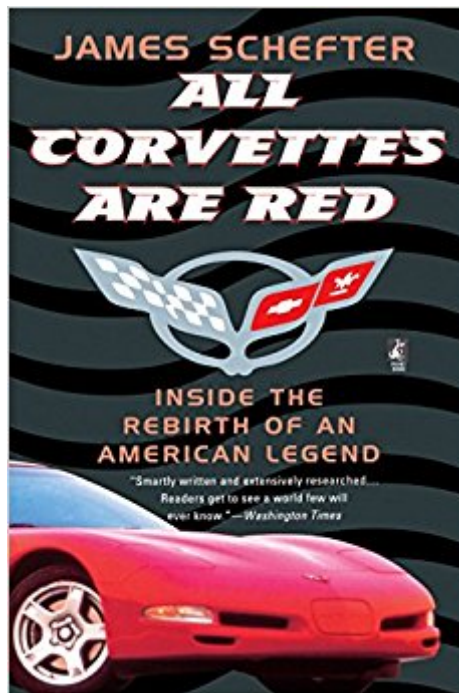




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All Corvettes Are Red (Inside The Rebirth Of An American Legend)

Mixed feelings. I bought this a few weeks after buying a fantastic 14 year old C5 Corvette. This book tells the complete story of how the C5 came to be... in almost agonizing detail. The extremely well researched look behind the scenes was both fascinating and a bit boring at the same time. Do I really need to know every little conflict or decision that was made at every meeting over the course of a few years? I really don't. But there were certainly enough interesting tid-bits to keep me interested (not quite done yet). After reading this book, it will seem in some ways, a miracle that the C5 (and beyond) survived at GM, but it also makes you understand how incredibly tragic (and stupid) it would have been for them to kill it off during the very turbulent early 90's. This would have made a fantastic 100-150 page abbreviated book, or as a series of articles. At ~350 pages, it feels a bit tedious, but I still encourage any Corvette fan, especially C5 fans, to add this to their library. As a software UI designer, I can appreciate the enormous amount of time the book talks about design teams and design issues - but if you're not into that, you may not enjoy it as much. Scan and skip if you have to, but there's some good stuff in there.
