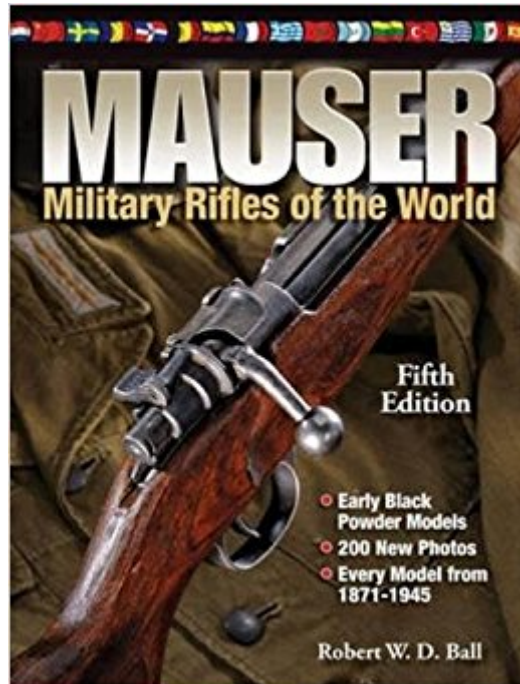


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Mauser Military Rifles Of The World

Robert W. D. Ball is an acknowledged authority on antique military rifles and memorabilia. He has authored a dozen books and travels the world in search of items to add to his collection.

Content is pretty much A+++. The physical book itself is like what other reviewers/purchasers described: print and paper quality is pretty bad. I was expecting glossy pages with beautiful photos. Nope. Thinking about returning, darn-it.

Sold book with a lot of information. I do wish it had far more info and pictures of proofs and arsenal stamping etc. Overall all good go to for collectors and enthusiasts alike.

Content of the book is still very good. However, this edition, "Fifth Edition" is of much poorer quality. The paper is nearly tissue thin and the photos much less sharp (due to the poorer quality paper) than all previous editions. I have all previous editions in my library and would rate the "Fourth Edition" as likely the best since it had expanded content and still used the high quality paper with excellent photo quality. If you do not yet have any of the previous editions of this book I would look for a copy of the "Fourth Edition" or any of the previous editions with much better overall quality, to include a dust jacket. This "Fifth Edition" does not come with a dust cover but has the same quality color cover.

I find this book both useful and entertaining. There is a wealth of information on the history rifle and loads of fantastic photos of the many variations of the gun. I particularly like the open pages that indexes the guns by the countries making it easy to look up the rifle of choice and explore future possible purchases. This is a must for the Mauser lover no matter if they are the avid collector with dozens of rifles or just someone with only one gun who is looking to explore the history of their prized shooter.
