

This is the definitive book on old outboard motors. Much has been written on individual motors, or brands, but none other, isall encompassing. Thumbnail outlines and brief history of all major and minor brands of antique outboard motors. Price guide is outdated but still the only general source, available.

It is a very interesting history of an obscure subject. Even though the engine values are around 20 years old they are relatively pertinent. The Evinrude history is especially fascinating. I highly recommend this book for those that are interested in the many facets of the outboard boat motor manufacturing business that are discussed in detail.
