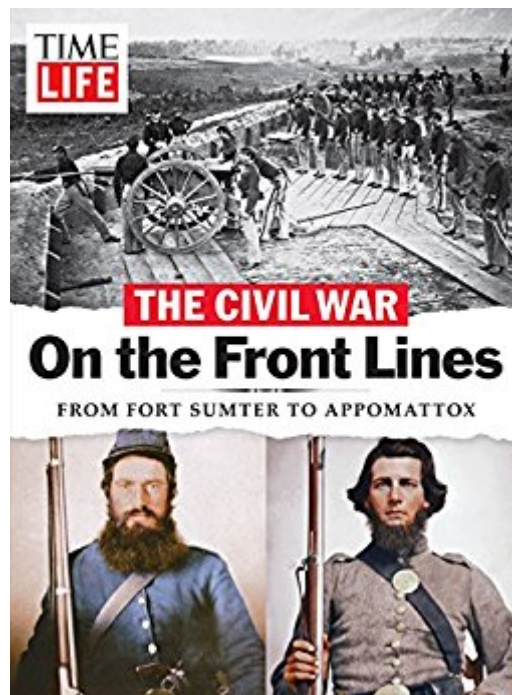




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TIME-LIFE The Civil War - On The Front Lines: From Fort Sumter To Appomattox

This 96 page publication is really an abbreviated version containing excerpts from the more comprehensive 271 page Time Life publication called, "The Civil War in 500 Photographs". It contains many interesting facts, pre-war issues, battles, descriptions, brief narratives, photographs and covers topics often overlooked in other Civil War Publications such as the role of women in the war, Native-American raids, the use of photography to cover the war, African-American Confederate soldiers and African-American Union soldiers. It is relatively unbiased and does not tilt toward being pro-Union nor Pro-Confederacy. It basically gives equal time to both sides of the war without being opinionated about the issues that lead to the war. It can be used to further one's interest in the Civil War era or simply added to one's collection. This would make for an excellent gift, but could be used as a great teaching tool.

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
