Lepowsky presents an ethnography of Vanatinai, a matrilineal, decentralized society in New Guinea where there is no ideology of male dominance and women and men are considered fundamentally equal. tracing the life cycle of islanders of both sexes, she examines the role of gender in the Vanatinai's: social life and history, religious philosophy and worldview, practice of ceremonial exchange and ritual. In addition, *Fruit of the Motherland* includes useful cross-cultural analysis of gender roles, ideologies, and power.
