

I have been looking for a book like this for awhile, from Rome, to Naples, to Pompeii and thank god I found it online at last - THE best book on Pompeii by far. All inclusive and highly visual - this is the FIRST and maybe only book one needs to buy on Pompeii. If you want to go further, I would also recommend Mary Beard's Pompeii: The Life of a Roman Town, the best nonfiction account, and Harris's fictional account Pompeii: A Novel. Both are wonderful. But the COMPLETE is The Best if you only want one book. It provides a great overview.
