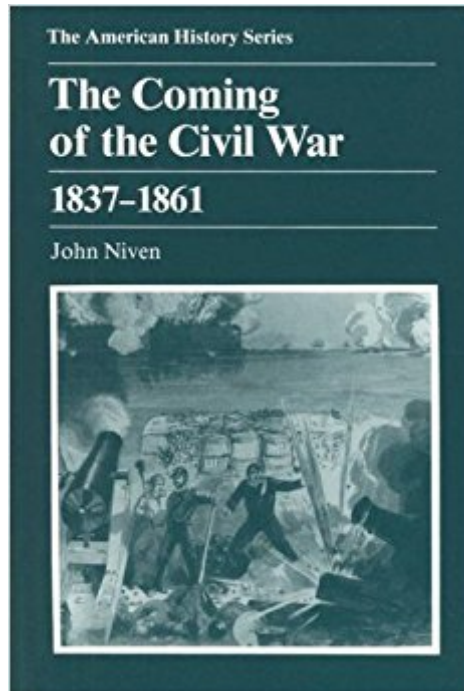




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The Coming Of The Civil War: 1837 - 1861
