

After living and working in Mexico City for five years I can say that Gonzalez is point on in his assertions about Hispanic culture and his book has greatly deepened my understanding and appreciation for that culture. A note to the publishers: If you're going to offer a Kindle version and charge full price for it, please do a proper edit job. The Kindle version is full of run-on words and misprints like Mariana for MaÃ±ana. But for your sloppy and unprofessional scanning to text job I would have given it 5 stars.

Just finished the 11 chapters of this book in one week. My God! my God! I love my Latino brothers and sisters so much because we are cut from the same cloth. When you begin to read scripture from the lived experience of a people you'll begin to understand why you may seem like an oddball. Try looking at Christ from the eyes of the peasant, the oppressed, the marginalized and you'll find a different Jesus than the one that was preached to you from a place of privilege
