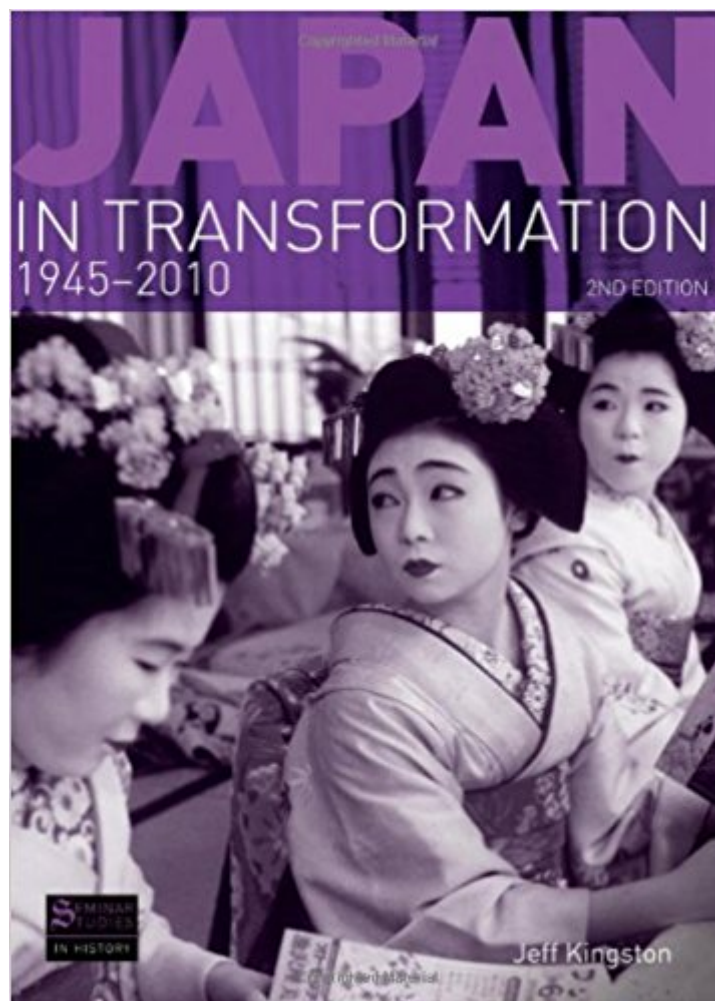


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Japan In Transformation, 1945-2010 (Seminar Studies)
