

If you are a Stephen Sondheim fan or perhaps a budding lyricist/show tune composer, then you should jump at the chance to own as many of these Sondheim full scores as you possibly can. Stephen Sondheim may not be the most commercially successful composer in Broadway history, but he is certainly one of the beacons of innovation and inspiration. And now you can see for yourself how the man does it and puts it all together. This particular volume covers every single note of music in Sondheim's Pulitzer Prize winning musical "Sunday In The Park With George". Every Sondheim score is a treasure trove of beautiful, intelligently composed music matched with possibly the best lyricwriting in the history of Broadway.
