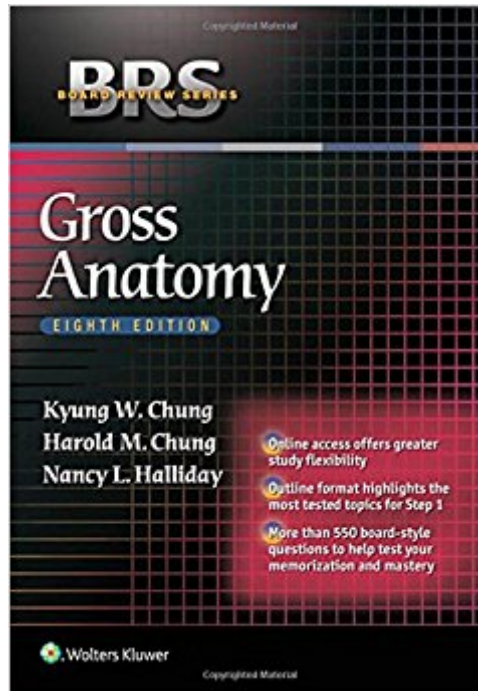

This is a very accessible and efficient anatomy book and what I would recommend first to any medical students. I find class and lab much easier if I first read the BRS book and try to get a basic overview. The biggest strength of this book is a review that helps integrate muscles, nerves, vessels, and actions, while also giving clinical correlates.

This book provided a great overall review of for the Gross Anatomy Shelf exam. It takes just enough detail combined with the right amount of broad brush strokes to review and drive home the important points of gross anatomy. I would highly recommend this book to anyone actively taking gross anatomy or reviewing for examination because it is helpful to both the student in learning and the examine in reviewing.
