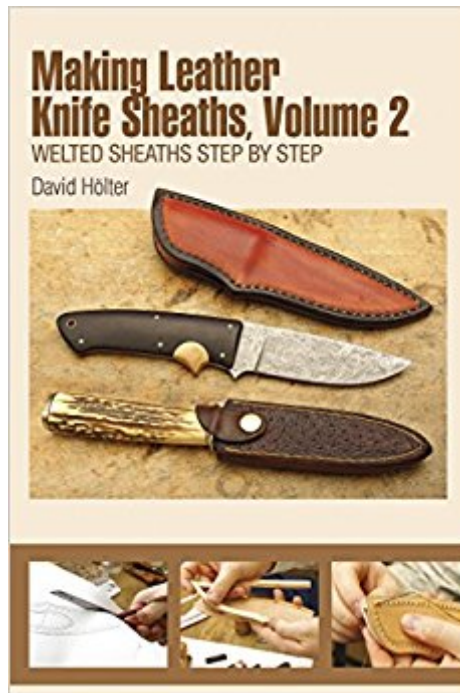

It seems the author likes pretty much one style of scabbard. This book is very basic much like volume 1. This Volume does have more build photos, however it offers very little more over Volume 1. With a little imagination you could build a better scabbard. It does have some data for leather care, dying, and shaping.
