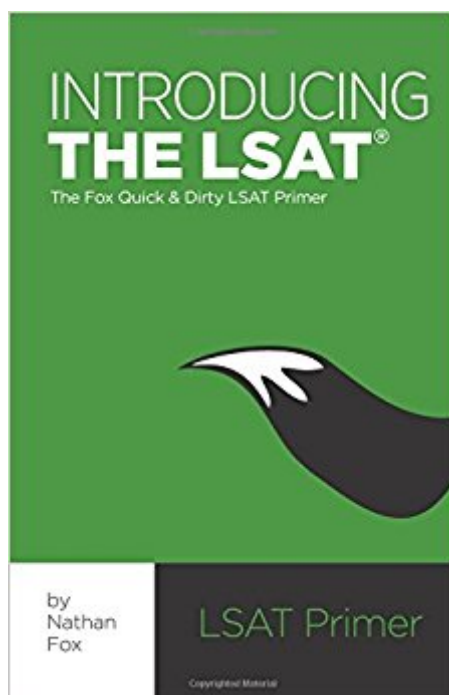

I love Nathan's sense of humor and no-nonsense approach to the LSAT. This is a bare-bones, beginner book - that is to say, it very quickly outlines the test and gives tips and tricks to get through it. It goes over each type of Analytical Reason question in depth, which I found very helpful. I would definitely purchase his other books. His point of view is so refreshing, and I loved the sometimes crass way he refers to the test - everyone is already thinking it!

Have you ever purchased a chunky test reviewer? Did this (insert brand name here) book leave you more confused and agitated than when you began studying? Nathan Fox's "Introducing the LSAT" is not that kind of book. He is brash and straight-to-the point... but in a good way. The way that forces you to get off of your hammock and actually take the time to practice. Yes, one of Fox's secrets is that there is no secret to getting a higher score - just practice. So how does this book help, you may ask. "Introducing..." breaks down each section of the LSAT and explains the process and reasoning behind his solutions. It explains why some choices are BS while some may initially smell like BS, but are not. Instead of simply listing an answer key at the back of the book, he takes the time to elaborate on how he arrives at each and every answer. Most importantly, he encourages us to take a combative attitude towards this standardized test. For reading comprehension questions, he urges us to ask the test makers, "Why are you wasting my time with this [passage]?" I have found that this mindset to be more effective than, "I don't get this text!" "Introducing the LSAT" is a compact booklet that is dense with practical test taking tips. Most of what Fox preaches can also be applied onto other standardized tests. Find out why it has helped so many students on their path to law school.

As everyone before me has said (or most likely should be saying), this is an absolute must to beginning the LSAT prep journey. Fox's no-nonsense writing and easy to understand explanations is a godsend amongst the most difficult problems. He provides confident breakdowns of real LSAT questions featured on past exams so you are getting exposure to the actual test from the very start. I recommend buying this book, reading it thoroughly cover-to-cover, and then purchasing additional necessary guides after assessing which areas of the LSAT you struggled the most on. Really take the time to purchase this book and give it your full attention, because there is no other book out on the market that will give you the knowledge and confidence you need to take the first step in the right direction.

If you are irritated by the big-box study guides' all-knowing, self-righteous tones, then buy this book. Nathan easily says, look, we've drilled it down to two s***ty answers, this is just the less s***ty one. Pick it and move on. I love the brevity of this book, but don't let its length fool you: it is full of tips and tricks to get you thinking precisely the way you need to in order to raise your score. This book has changed the way that I approach each test and my scores have definitely improved. Nathan is also just as accessible by email as he says! I submitted a question on his website and he wrote back to me the next day with a solution. Watch his videos, too. Trust Nathan, read his book, watch his videos.

A good value, especially at the price of the Kindle edition. I'd recommend this as a useful prelude for those who, like me, don't intend to purchase other books or courses besides the practice tests in LSAC's PrepTest series. This book contains some useful techniques and tips. Kindle edition notes: it's not compatible with my Voyage, which caused me some head-scratching as to why my Kindle device was grayed out in the "deliver to:" drop-down menu. And there is some material for which the paper version would be more convenient in switching back and forth from the question text to discussion a few pages later, as the Kindle shows only one page at a time.

I'm giving this book 5 stars but while I think the book does a great job at quickly and thoughtfully breaking down the LR section, it's merely an intro for the other 2 graded sections. This is evidenced by the fact that 3/4 of the book is dedicated to LR while the remainder is split between the other 2. With that said however, I'm now flying through LR questions so definitely worth it!!! After reading this book, Nathan is the little voice inside my head while I'm doing LR questions just because he makes the explanations so relatable! Maybe that's because I, myself, am a "potty mouth" with a

borderline offensive humor but it works for me. I also love the arrested development reference! Definitely worth the cheap price tag but I'd pay several times that for this little gem.

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
