

In this down-to-earth exercise in evangelical theology, Ingram, a radio show host and CEO of the Atlanta-based organization Walk Through the Bible, makes the case that understanding the character of God as He reveals Himself is the most important task facing new Christians and seasoned believers alike. Noting that his analysis is meant to be devotional and practical rather than comprehensive, Ingram focuses on seven traits attributed to God: goodness, sovereignty, holiness, wisdom, justice, love and faithfulness. Although Ingram relies on the work of evangelical heavyweights like C.S. Lewis and A.W. Tozer to make his points, his primary sources in answering questions about such conundrums as why God allows suffering or the nature of Christ's sacrificial atonement for sin are the Old and New Testaments. One caveat: though Ingram's style is accessible and often engaging, his methodical and rather pedagogical style may narrow his

potential audience to readers comfortable with the traditional language of conservative apologetics. The premise is right on. Sometimes the author isn't careful with his use of language, for example, "generosity expresses the simple wish that others should have what they need to make them happy." Happy? Have you ever tried to make someone happy and find out what they need to make them happy is a black hole? Although he is quoting someone else, he is agreeing with it. The term, "happy" is imprecise.

The reader of the book skips phrases and whole paragraphs, some of which are important points made in the book. As a result, it is impossible to read along in the physical book along with the reader of the audio book. I talked with the publisher and they do not provide an unabridged version which does not take license with what they are reading. I had to send the audio book back.

I enjoyed the book very much, it is very uplifting. It gives one a whole new perspective of the creator. Mr Ingram did a wonderful job of writing, on such a complicated subject.

It's important to know that the book works through the 'characteristics' of God and takes each one

step by step. It's not necessarily a quick read through, so much as a 'take it chapter by chapter' and meditate on it to allow time for the information to resonate and sink in. We are currently in small group working through this book and I've seen quite a few 'ah ha' moments on the faces of our group members and for me, I've underlined and spent time really enjoying the teachings and encouragement this book offers.

I've never come across a message so clear. It comes from a scholar of the Bible. Chip creates a clear message that is easy to take in and understand. I do not have enough time or frankly know how to examine the Bible the way I wish I could. Chip has done this and provides the answers we are looking for. Having dedicated himself to providing a clear and inspiring revelation into how we can and should understand who God is - and not what the world tells us He is. This is a book which takes a look through an unusual lens. We don't often think about how God wants us to see him. I feel that Chip Ingram had some important things to say. Where I feel the book broke down a bit was that he seemed to be going over very similar material in each chapter. This book would have been wonderful if limited to 2 or 3 chapters, as it is written it starts to become tedious by the end of the book. This is designed for a committed group study, and with such a group it can be a valuable study.

I haven't read a book by Chip Ingram that I haven't liked. This book did not disappoint--it exceeded my expectations! It helped to demolish the misperceptions I had of God; and it helped to build a new, more accurate, vision of God in me. I would recommend this book to everyone, especially to those who don't know God well or are struggling with their image of Him!
