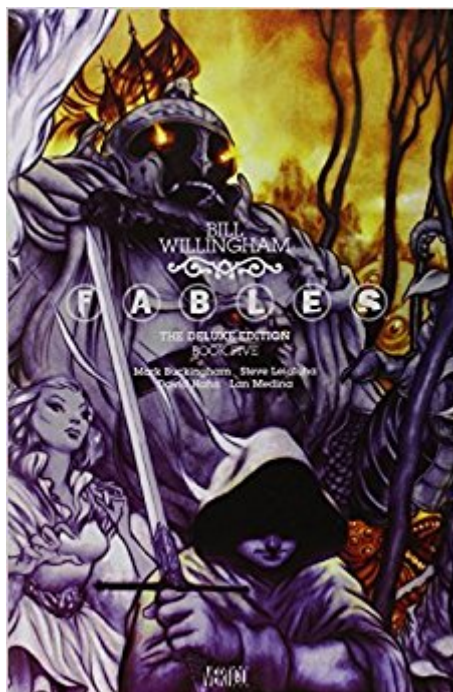

Bill Willingham is the award-winning writer and creator of FABLES. He has been writing, and sometimes drawing, comics for more than twenty years on titles including Elementals, Coventry, PROPOSITION PLAYER and FABLES. With Matthew Sturges, Bill co-wrote the FABLES spinoff JACK OF FABLES, as well as HOUSE OF MYSTERY and JUSTICE SOCIETY OF AMERICA. His work has been nominated for many awards, including the Eisner, Harvey and Ignatz comic industry awards, plus the International Horror Guild award.

This is an absurdly creative graphic novel equal in calibre to the works of Alan Moore and Neil Gaiman. The oversize deluxe edition with gorgeous dust cover is a fabulous way of reading this

sweeping epic of fable fantasy for mature audiences, especially if you are a first time reader like me. When you consider the price of comics these days, this is a high value way of collecting this series since each edition has close to 10 comics and can be found on at about 40% of MSRP (or around \$16 each + shipping). The comics are printed on high quality paper and the print quality is superb. The binding is glued which is not a problem given the size of the publication; it is of course problematic for the larger DC omnibus or absolute editions. Sometimes the comic is printed a little too close to the binding making it difficult to read, but these occurrences are rare. This a much high value product than the DC archives series which retails for \$49.95 or higher. My only real complaint is the use of multiple artists on the same fable character across this epic. This normally would not be a problem if the artwork were equal across artists and if there was little variation in how the characters are portrayed. Some artwork is brilliant and some downright crude. Finally some of the stories are trite and should have been omitted. But overall we can ignore these disappointments. I definitely will collect the entire series.

great and good shipping

A rare misstep in this series. The inclusion of the Werewolves of the Heartland also bothered me as this was already released in hardcover, so it really felt as if it was just padding to this volume. The real problem here is that this storyline has no affect on the main Fables story. This really is much more important for the Jack of Fables series and really just feels out of place here. Unless you really want the complete collection, I would pass on this volume. Still gets three stars, because its still Fables.

This one starts off terrible in my opinion, the beginning focuses on Jack on a bit of a side story and is pretty boring and uninteresting for the most part. It has a purpose but won't keep you entertained. The other stories really pick up and give you a lot more about the world of fables. If for some reason you are at all waning on the series, this set would snatch you right back up. As always with this Deluxe series, you can expect the same high quality hard cover with glossy cover. I can't wait for the rest of the series to end up with the deluxe treatment!

I've said in other volumes of this that the binding is a bit weird, and cuts off images a bit near the spine but otherwise very good.

What can i say? I am a collector of these books. I have read a lot of Bill Willinghams work and many different fables. I think that these are great and i would recommend that you buy these deluxe books if you dont do comics but enjoy graphic novels. The art is just awesome.

The writing is indeed excellent, and the artwork could not be a better pairing to the prose. Buckingham has this old school feel to his artwork that fits this story like a glove. These two guys were meant to do this title together. If you haven't ever read Fables...shame on you! Are you not curious to find out what ever happened to Mowgli or Snow White, Little Boy Blue, or Aladdin and his lamp? Don't you want to catch up with the three little pigs or Pinnochio? They are all there...in the Woodlands, waiting for you to read their stories. Remember that those woods can be dark, and maybe leave some bread crumbs so you don't get too lost. And beware the Goblins...and the dread sound of snicker snack...snicker snack...
