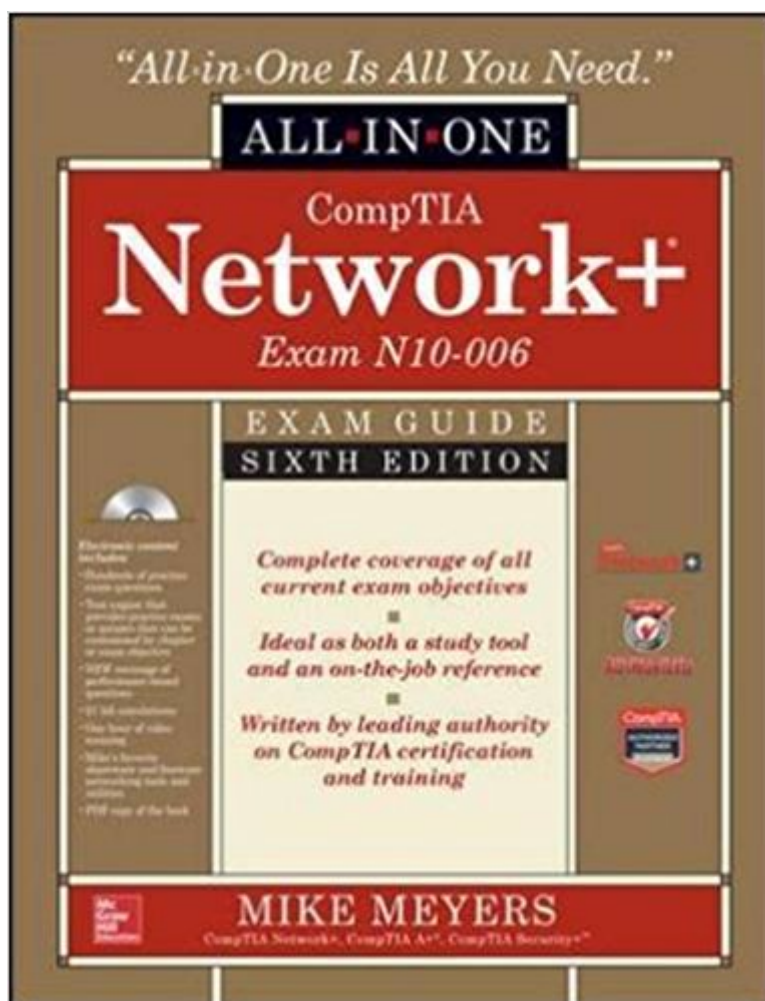

The book even divides the book into history and test specific which I appreciated because you can skip to what's pertinent. Now, where the book fell short is how they advertise all of these supplemental features like practice tests. It's a farce... They are just samples to get you to buy his products from his company. The files are not accessible on mobile devices. The book is a good companion to the Lynda.com Network+ course.

Really a good read! I have taken a Network course at the local College, and have read the CompTIA Network+ text (twice). I really want to pass the test, so I thought I would try Mike Meyers book to do one last review of the subject. I bought it because the reviews of the book are very good, but I was hesitant to spend this much for another book like the one I had. I found this is worth it! Mike is so easy to read and understand. He fills in details the other Network book leaves out, gives little tidbits and examples. I used Mike's books for CompTIA A+ and passed, so wish I had bought this in the first place.

It is a good book if your starting from the ground up. I have 25 years of IT experience and was just trying to get some certs back on my resume. I quickly got tired of combing through this book looking for the bits I didn't know and got a different book with less fluff and more pointed details. However, I enjoyed reading it. It was well written and covered most of the material. But not all so you will still

need to pull from several other resources. I passed on the first try but it was a rather difficult test due to the vast amount of material covered.

Very broad book, covering the essentials. Well-organized. Great if you are relatively new to networking. Clear, slightly irreverent tone, which made the book as fun to read as a technical book can be. Is definitely not all you need to pass the exam, but provides an excellent foundation. Some errors. I emailed Meyers' company to get errata; never heard back from them. The Total Tester software that comes with the book is really good. Pair this with Glen E. Clarke's Network+ book and you'll have a winning combination.

This is a great book full of tons of information. This book is exactly the same that you get elsewhere for twice as much. This book covers EVERYTHING that you will need for the Net+ and the videos that Mike Meyers does on Udemy also follow the book which is really helpful.

The only way to start studying for the CompTIA Network+ exam. I used book that was current 17 years ago to get my first certification in Net+. Mike Meyers and the publishers have come a long way in tuning the training. This is much better organized in a way the greatly helps me memorize that parts I need and ignore the rest. The testing tips show a lot of thought and the teaching aids, though a bit clunky and primitive do a good job at anchoring what you know so that you can remember it at test time.

Excellent book for the Network+ exam. Tried another book by Pearson and it left many items out. Meyers covers all the material on the test in an easy to understand format. Some books go through the objectives in order, leaving you to figure out material that will be covered later. This book is in a learning sequence and a conversation style. Mike Meyers also explains how you will use what your learning and how and what it will be used with, not just definitions. The CompTIA Network+ asks a fair amount of questions in troubleshooting scenarios. You will have to know more than just the definition of a protocol to get by. I Highly recommend this book for the Network+ exam.
