

I received this book a few days ago. Usually I would have read through by now but because of a very busy week, I have not. But i have been reading it every chance I get! I'll start by saying this book is straightforward. Some may even call it basic. Being a woman that grew up in a Southern Baptist church and have been saved since I was young, I only really came to follow God in a committed way last year. That meant that while I did technically know Jesus there were a lot of things that needed to be CORRECTED. My interpretation and understanding of grace is definitely one of them! Especially because this is something we can brush off like "yeh, yeh...i know..." when knowing with your head and heart are two different things! What I enjoy about this book is that the language is straightforward and divided up nicely. As I read through the book, I felt convicted in certain areas because I know I had thought that way or did this or that. But it was a good conviction because it followed it up with the truth. Someone might think this is "basic" but I don't think it is. In a sense, it is a basic concept...these are things we should know as Christians but it is something that if not paid attention to can lead to incorrect thinking. Grace is such an important and necessary truth

to understand CORRECTLY because it is the basis of our Christian faith. Even I thought I understood grace but Mr. Bridges definitely pointed out somethings I was definitely guilty of. I am prayerfully reading this book asking God to make His love and grace not just something I know in my head but that I know it in my heart in a deep way. I would recommend this book to everyone, new Christians, old Christians, etc. =DCan't wait to read some of his other books!

Material is well organized and consistent with the teachings of Scripture. The study guide can be used separately from the book because of the chapter summaries and interactive questions which require one to study the Bible for answers. I have used this while leading mixed small group studies and men's Bible studies.
