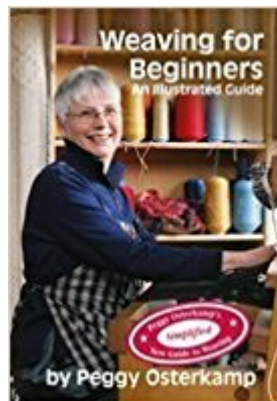

I'm very impressed with her book--she has even included suggested projects to help the reader develop and improve their weaving skills. The only negative aspect to my transaction was that the book arrived with two corners slightly bent--the shipping method simply did not protect the book enough.
