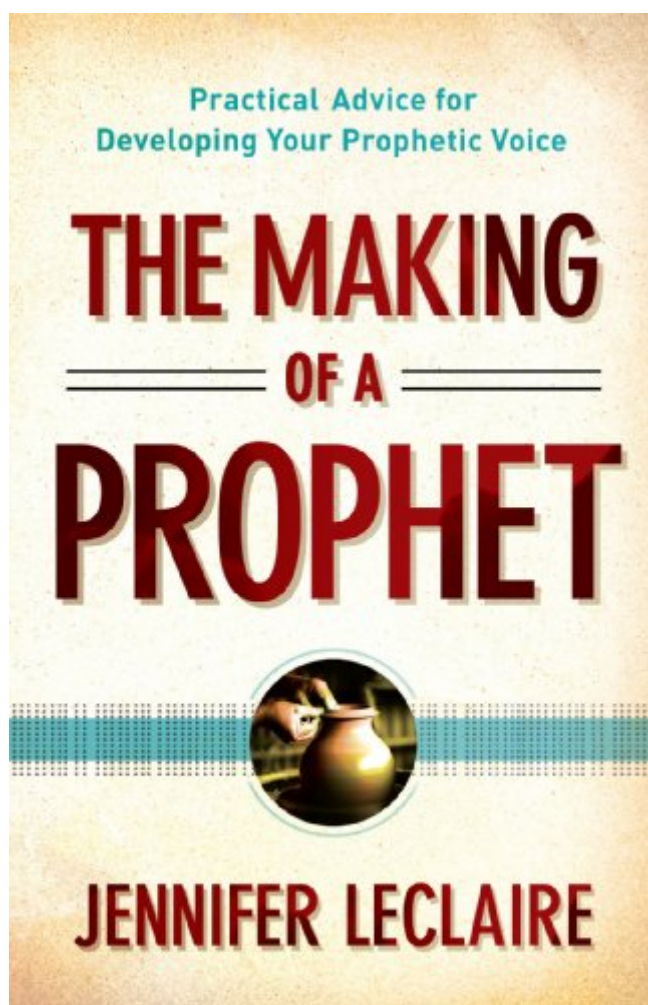


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The Making Of A Prophet: Practical Advice For Developing Your Prophetic Voice

This book is a good little book for those new to the prophetic ministry or those just beginning to study the prophetic ministry. Basically, it's a good book for beginners. I would not recommend this book for those who are mature in the prophetic ministry or those having studied it in depth already, as most of the material contained in the book is more "milk" for beginners and not "meat" for more experienced prophetic ministers. I would recommend some of Bill Hammond's books on prophetic ministry as he has written many of them and they are more in-depth and go into the subject more fully.

I really enjoyed reading this book. It was very practical and gave insights into the office of a prophet. Many want to be called or want the title of a prophet but few are really chosen. Jennifer LeClaire gives insights from her own personal experience that help guide you into your own path and help you figure out if God is calling you in that direction or not. She explains that the office of prophet has great responsibility with it and how some can get in error if they do not have accountability.. She also shares that there are some things that you battle just because you have been called to that particular ministry. I would recommend this book if you feel called to this ministry.
