These vocabulary cards are quite the material that will make taking the SAT a snap. It's quite large in both volume and in size. I can fit the whole case from the top of my fingers down to the bottom of my hand, and I do indeed have large hands. It's very compact for the amount of material it contains though. You can fit this case in your backpack, so in between classes and free time you can study to your heart's content. It's chock full of material, showing the parts of speech, definition, and synonym of the word. The flash cards are average size with smooth borders and quality paper. Not some flimsy printer paper or anything of the sort. It's composed of either words you may have learned in class, or new words that can expand your vocabulary. It's not filled with words that you may use in general conversations, but that is different for everyone. I would recommend this product to anyone wanting to increase their Writing/Critical Reading scores on the SAT!

These cards are an easy way to boost your SAT-specific vocabulary. The flashcard format allows for quick repetition, more than with books in my opinion. I only wish they had pronunciation keys next to the definitions. I recommend these cards along with "Verbal Advantage" and a pocket dictionary for a lasting vocabulary increase. Daily reading, however, is still your best bet for a lifelong and effective vocabulary. These cards are just tools to speed up the process.

I like the cards because these words do appear often in the SAT. I was disappointed that more than half of the words were fairly easy or common words most people should know if they are taking steps to improve their vocabulary for the test. Often times, students who get this big packages with hundreds of words to learn care enough about the SAT or are trying to go leaps and bounds and need to know more tougher words for that great score. This products doesn't have too many of those tough words but it is better than any other SAT flash card box out there.

Absolutely, these flashcards is the best one but as we all know the sat format changed so don't waste your money and wait new editions.

This set of cards can be very helpful if you are preparing for the SAT and your vocabulary bank needs more work. However, the effect of these study cards will vary greatly from person to person, as this set contains some words that are used in everyday language and I really would not consider them to be "SAT vocabulary". If you already have a very good knowledge of SAT vocabulary, then

you should look elsewhere. If you need work and need to learn SAT vocabulary quick, buying this will give you an easy and effective tool to the understanding of the basic words found in the SAT. By no means will this completely prepare you for EVERY word you will see on the SAT however, and if that was your goal, then you should complement this with more vocab to study.

I'm an SAT tutor, and I recommend this product for most of my students. It's helpful not just for the Sentence Completions, but for the whole Critical Reading section- many of these words show up in the long passages and the corresponding questions. It's true that students could make their own flashcards, but very few students are diligent enough to do that. This box gives them a huge number of useful words to learn, and having a sturdy box and dividers is invaluable to keep things organized. It's priced very reasonably for the quality you get. What keeps it from getting 5 stars? No pronunciation key for the words, and the definitions could be simpler.

These cards have very basic English vocab words like "adept" and "predecessor". I use them with a 12-year-old girl I tutor. So far, we haven't run across any words that she already knows. Studying with flashcards is a good activity for her. We can quickly run through a few cards as a break from other tutoring activities. I can't give 5 stars, because sometimes the definitions on the cards are too advanced and use words of equal or greater difficulty, e.g. using "transitory" to define "transient". When teaching someone with a rudimentary vocabulary, I'd prefer to have definitions that use simple words. The cards are somewhat flimsy and could bend or tear easily. Use with care, and store them in the box. The box does come with a nice divider to place between the words you've learned and the rest of the set. It also has quite a few blank cards for adding your own vocab words. Each card does include a sentence for the word that helps put its use in context as well as a couple of synonyms. Overall, these were a good buy. I would recommend them for middle school students and their parents and teachers. I am looking for something more advanced to recommend to my high school students.

These vocab words are great for studying. They are definitely worth learning. The cards themselves look very nice. They flip upside down, so it's easier than turning them over the long way. I found most, but not all definitions, to be good. I would definitely recommend these to anyone taking the SAT.

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
