

I've recently started hand dying my own yarn and have been looking for resources that would guide me in learning more about this art. I bought this book hoping to discover new techniques and to refine some skills but was bitterly disappointed. The 'book' could be more accurately described as a brochure with very little information and even fewer pages! Very unhappy I wasted my money.

This book has clear instructions on the basics of dyeing, and is set out in a logical, step by step format. Ideal for a beginner dyer, covering both methods of dyeing and some of the dyes available, as well as detailed instructions on a few colourways and formulas. If you can only get one book, and are just starting out, this would be a good one to choose.

I've really enjoyed this book. It's very well written with clear directions and beautiful projects. I have been a member of Kindle Unlimited from the beginning but have been finding their recently available books to be lackluster and second rate. I am finally cancelling my membership. THIS will be the only book offered via Kindle Unlimited I purchase outright and keep.
