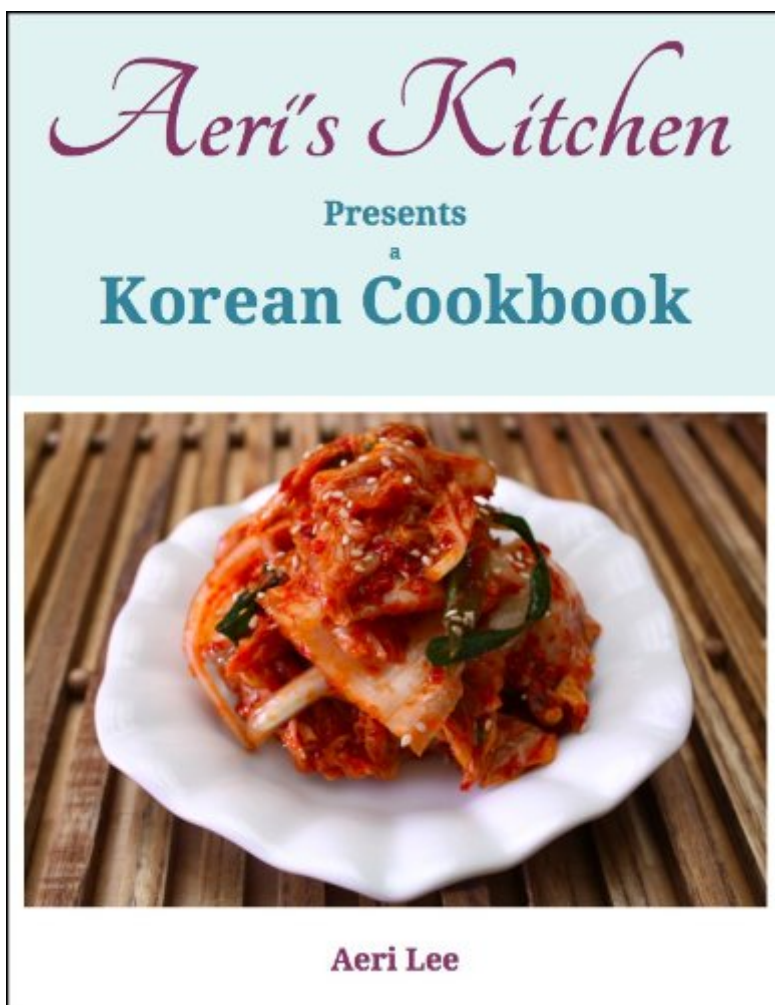




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Aeri's Kitchen Presents A Korean Cookbook

I haven't tried all of them, but I have tried several and all of my experiments with these recipes turned out great and received praise from my Korean born-and-raised friends. I actually live in Korea, but it is hard to find a Korean cookbook here that isn't in Korean. However, after my friend suggested Aeri's Kitchen online, I loved the recipes and how easy it was to follow that I purchased the book and I don't regret it. A lot of the foreign born Koreans that we know here in Korea who have married Korean men use this cookbook. None of them have had any complaints about their Korean cooking skills (and trust me, Koreans will complain! They don't see it as an insult, but as a favor that they

What I love is that this book is basically a collection of all her blog recipes in one cheap book! The layout on the Kindle is simple and clean. If I want to be extra sure about a recipe, I can always go to her Youtube channel but it is good to get the e-book because it is cheap and since it is on my kindle, I can have it readily available in the kitchen when I follow the recipe!
