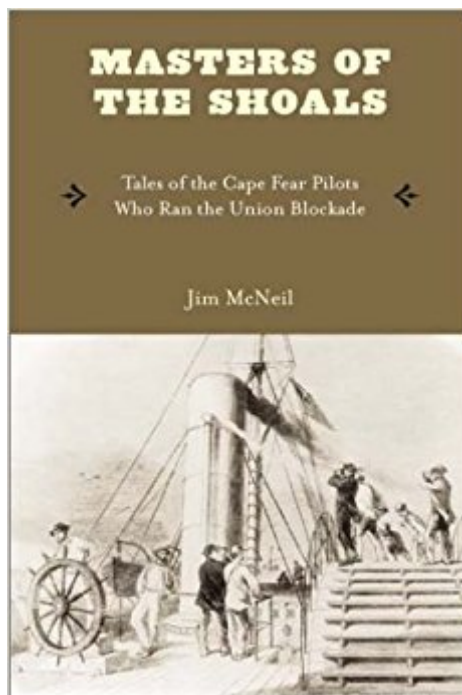




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Masters Of The Shoals: Tales Of The Cape Fear Pilots Who Ran The Union Blockade
